YEARLY BUDGET FOR FAMILY CHILD CARE PROVIDERS

The figures used to prepare this budget reflect a mid-range of expenses incurred to operate a family child care home. The sample budget is based on the following assumptions:

- The provider will be registered to care for 8 children, including two children under the age of two, but only has 7 children in care currently.
- The provider's own children are over the age of six.
- Each family pays a non-refundable registration fee of \$50.
- The provider participates in the Tier 1 Child and Adult Care Food Program for 240 active days.
- The provider is buying her home and has a mortgage of \$80,000.
- The time/space percentage is figured at 28%.
- The provider is open 11 hours per day and receives pay for 260 days per year (52 weeks).
